

How to build a resume in USAJOBS

1 Create a **USAJOBS** account

Complete your profile prior to resume building

2 Go to Document

Under the **Resumes** section, select the **Upload or build resume** button.



3 Click Build Resume

Name your new resume and click Next.

Add Work Experience

Enter the required information and click **Save Work Experience**, then **Next** to continue.

Add Education

Enter the required information and click **Save Education**. Repeat this step if necessary, then click **Next**. You may also click **Finish** if you don't want to add more information. Save all required information.

Add Reference

Enter the required information and click **Save Reference**. Repeat this step if necessary, then click **Next** to continue to the next step.

Add Additional Information

Enter additional information such as job related training, language skills, organizations/affiliations, professional publications, and other information. Click **Add** or **Save** for each section once completed.

Click Finish to save your resume. Your new resume will appear in your Documents list.

How to make a resume searchable


Making your resume searchable adds it to the USAJOBS Resume Mining collection, helping HR specialists and hiring managers from federal agencies look for applicants (with a USAJOBS profile) for their job announcements.

To make your resume searchable:

- 1. Sign into USAJOBS.
- 2. Go to **Documents**—your resumes will appear in your Documents.
- 3. Click the **Searchable** checkbox on the resume you want to make searchable.

If you want to remove your resume from the Resume Mining collection, unselect the **Searchable** checkbox.

- Only one of your resumes can be made searchable at a time.
- Only certain formats are searchable including Word, text based pdfs, text files and resumes created using our Resume Builder tool.
- Your resume will only remain searchable for 18 months unless it is renewed.
