Through a collaborative mentoring environment and simulated graduate school experiences, students will gain the competencies needed to graduate as distinguished scholars with enhanced communication, leadership, intercultural, research methodology, and critical thinking skills. The McNair Scholars Program has been at the University of Delaware since 1999.



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must:

- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Have completed 60 credits by May 31st
- Be a low-income, first-generation student and/or from an underrepresented background in graduate education
