

Linda Myrick Retired as General Manager, Hydrogen Peroxide, North America Arkema Inc.

Linda recently retired from Arkema Inc., a French-based specialty chemicals and materials manufacturer as the General Manager, Hydrogen Peroxide, North America. Since 2017, she was responsible for leadership of the business unit including manufacturing locations in the US and Canada, and served on the Arkema Inc. Management Committee and Hydrogen Peroxide Global Leadership Team.

Prior to Arkema, Linda worked for Air Liquide, Inc. since the acquisition of Scott Specialty Gases including 3 years in Paris, France as the R&D Group Manager for Medical Gases for Air Liquide Santé International managing clinical and pre-clinical trial activity in Europe. She returned to Newark DE where she was responsible for global R&D programs for Food, Pharmaceutical, Water and Waste Treatment, Biofuels and Medical Technologies.

Before joining Scott in 2004, she held executive positions with Rhoda Inc. including Vice President & General Manager - North America, Home, Personal Care & Industrial Ingredients, and Vice President & General Manager - North America, Specialty Phosphates and for FMC Corporation in marketing, strategic planning and as Division Manager for Active Oxidants and for FMC Biopolymer, Pharmaceuticals.

Linda was an independent Board member for Innophos, Inc., a NASDAQ-traded specialty phosphate manufacturer from 2007 - 2020, where she was Chair of the Nominating & Governance Committee, and a member of the Audit and the Compensation Committees.

Linda earned a BS in Chemical Engineering from the University of Delaware and an MBA from the Wharton Graduate School of the University of Pennsylvania.
